This is the London Underground. Four million people use the underground every day. And twenty thousand people work on it. It's 6.14 in the evening, rush hour. A million tired Londoners go home. But when rush hour finishes, six and a half thousand Underground workers start their night's work. By 1.00 a.m. everything is quiet. At Waterloo, supervisor Dave closes the Underground station. He's here alone all night until seven o'clock in the morning. At Blackhorse Road Station a team of tunnel cleaners go to work. They clean three hundred metres of tunnel every night. At Regent's Park Station, engineers change a broken rail.

It's 7.15 in the morning. The London Underground starts again. No one thinks about the people who work at night on the Underground. But their work is important.
